

Background and objective

The National Community-Driven Development Programme (PNDP) is one of the operational tools of Cameroon Government to support the progressive decentralization process. Among other things, it aims to define and implement mechanisms to hand over responsibility to local communities and their Local and Regional Authorities in order to become directly involved in their own development.

Within the framework of the implementation of the second phase of the C2D funding allocated to the PNDP, a component aimed at Reducing



Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation «REDD+» is being implemented.

Officially launched on February 14, 2014 by the Minister of Environment, Nature Protection and Sustainable Development (MINEPDED), the REDD+ component aims to contribute to the National REDD+ Strategy led by MINEPDED through the implementation of five (05) REDD+ (inter) municipal pilot projects in the five (5) agro-ecological zones of Cameroon.

Main results

- Ten (10) Project Idea Notes (PINs) are available and approved;
- 2. Five (05) REDD+ (inter) municipal projects are selected and implemented in all agroecological zones of Cameroon;
- The National Coordination, Regional Coordinations, Divisional Technical Committees, as well as Local Platforms of conflict management, foreseen in the Readiness-Proposal Project (R-PP), are supported by the PNDP;
- The results and lessons learnt from the project are known, capitalized and disseminated at national, sub-regional and international levels.

Beneficiaries

- I. Councils or group of councils project holders:
 - The Yoko council and the Belabo – Doume – Diang group of councils for the agro-ecological zone of moist forest with bimodal pluviometry;



- The Ekondo-Titi-Bamusso group of councils and Tiko council for the agro-ecological zone of moist forest with monomodal pluviometry;
- Nyambaka and Meiganga councils for the guinean high savannah agro-ecological zone;
- Kumbo council and Bangangte Bangou Bana group of councils for the grassfields agro-ecological zone;
- Lagdo and Pitoa councils for the sudano-sahelian agro-ecological zone;
- 2. Local Support Organisations;
- Ministries concerned and the PNDP;
- 4. The decentralized services of the REDD+ National Coordination.
